

ORDER OF ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS

SECTION 1: The Board of Trustees of the Galena Park Independent School District desires and orders that an election be held in the Galena Park Independent School District for the year 2019-2020 for the purpose of electing a Board for regular terms.

Candidates for this election may file for a position in the name of the School Administration Office, 14705 Westwood Blvd., Houston, Texas, 77015 beginning on January 15, 2020 and no later than 5:00 p.m. on February 14, 2020.

SECTION 2: The District shall be divided into (6) election precincts for this election and the polling places assigned for each election precinct and the persons to be appointed to serve as Presiding Judges and Assistant Judges shall be shown in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Each presiding Judge shall appoint not less than two (2) nor more than five (5) qualified clerks to serve and assist in holding said election; provided that if the Presiding Judge shall be unable to do so, he or she may appoint one or more clerks.

On Election Day, May 2, 2020, the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

The School Administration Building, 14705 Westwood Boulevard, Houston, Texas 77015 (mailing address P. O. Box 1777, Galena Park, Texas, 77547) shall be the main early voting place. Applications for ballot by mail shall be received by the Galena Park Independent School District or emailed to vkillion@galenaparkisd.com, Early Voting Office and returned to the same address or emailed to vkillion@galenaparkisd.com, Early Voting Office not later than April 29, 2020.

If an application for ballot by mail (ABM) is faxed or mailed, or if a federal postal application is used, the applicant must submit the original application to the Early Voting Office by mail so that the clerk receives the original application the fourth (4th) business day after receiving the emailed or faxed or mailed ABM or the Early Voting Office. If the original ABM or FPA is not received by the clerk by the fourth (4th) business day after receiving the emailed or faxed or mailed ABM or FPA, the clerk shall not count the application as a ballot.

Early voting shall be conducted from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. each day except on April 28, 2020, through April 28, 2020, except April 28, 2020, on which early voting shall be conducted from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Branch office for early voting by personal appearance is hereby established and shall remain in effect during the period for early voting at the Galena Park Independent School District. The hours of operation for each branch office for early voting, the hours designated for early voting by personal appearance at each branch office shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day except on April 28, 2020, on which early voting shall be conducted from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

For purposes of this election, the hours of operation for each branch office for early voting shall be from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. each day except on April 28, 2020, on which early voting shall be conducted from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

SECTION 3: A DBR Voting System shall be used in this election as follows: For each voting place designated by mail by mail and each voter shall receive his vote on the DBR Voting System and the voting system shall be used for all voting.
